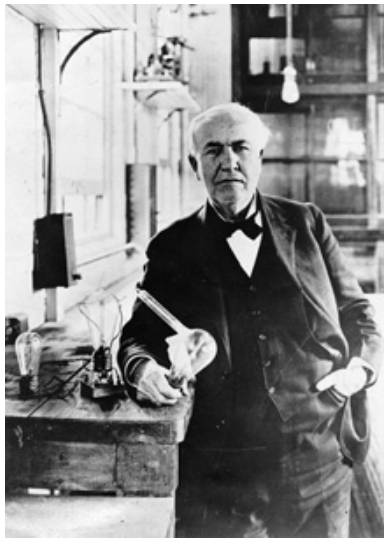

WHAT IS THE EDISON EXPOSITION?

The Edison Exposition is a PTA-sponsored, non-competitive science fair that showcases science concepts, science experiments and original inventions. Students in grades K-6 are encouraged to participate at their own grade-appropriate levels.

This is an optional event intended to spark creativity and introduce application of the scientific method. Participants will utilize the skills of investigating, observing, hypothesizing, experimenting and writing. Participation in the Edison Expo will give you the opportunity to further explore an interesting concept and share that experience with your classmates and the Wolf Trap community.

Can you think of a question that you would like to discover the answer to? Once you think of a question, you can design an experiment and do research to try to find the answer. IMPORTANT EXPO DATES & TIMES

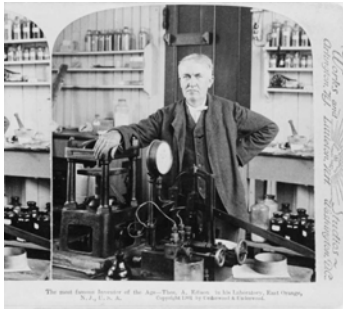
- **March 2** -

 - 11:50-12:05 PM - PM Kindergarteners bring projects to school during AM or at afternoon arrival time
 - (volunteers will help you transport your project to your classroom)
 - 6:30-8:00 PM - HAVE FUN AT THE FAIR! Projects left at the end of the Expo will be discarded.
 - Grades K-2 projects will be displayed in the cafeteria
 - Grades 3-6 projects will be displayed in the gym

NOTES TO PARENTS

Encourage your child while he/she designs or researches the project. Resist the temptation to "help out" too much. K-1 students may dictate the narrative parts of the project to their parents. We will happily exhibit unfinished projects as "works in progress." Similarly, an experiment or invention that doesn't work as anticipated provides a great basis for "lessons learned". We will welcome those projects too.
