Because these bulbs are more energy efficient, many people are using them to replace their old bulbs. However, they contain mercury, so often people wonder how to dispose of them. Now you can bring them to Wolftrap to recycle!

## **Battery Recycling through Radio Shack**

Wolftrap's SCA is sponsoring a battery recycling program. The program was designed to help recycle the dry cell batteries accumulated from wireless household products. By recycling your batteries properly, you will be keeping in compliance with current environmental regulations, managing your waste stream properly and limiting your exposure to liability....and setting a good example for everyone to keep our environment healthy.

Wolftrap's SCA is sponsoring a cell phone recycling program through Cell Phones for Soldiers. Cell Phones for Soldiers hopes to turn old cell phones into more than 12 million minutes of prepaid calling cards for U.S. troops stationed overseas in 2008. The phones are sent to ReCellular, which pays Cell Phones for Soldiers for each donated phone – enough to provide an hour of talk time to soldiers abroad.
